



Southern Safety Gets a Boost from ANT AUDITOR

The previous Southern system was largely paper based and was slow in reporting and analysing results. ANT AUDITOR uses PDAs with email data transfer facilities, which allow inspectors to provide an immediate and comprehensive action report for the local manager and send a copy back to head office.

ANT AUDITOR enables Southern to share information quickly and effectively throughout the management chain resulting in potential at-risk areas being identified and eliminated.

ANT AUDITOR's flexibility enables Southern to constantly monitor, change and develop their audits to encompass changes to both business and legislative requirements. In addition, the simplicity of the ANT system means that even though Southern are based some distance from ANT's office, the system was installed very quickly and support can be provided remotely.
